## NOTICE OF RACE

**REGATTA ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:** Performance Handicap Racing Fleet of Southern California (PHRF So Cal) is the organizing authority for this regatta, PHRF So Cal shall be responsible for: (1) accepting and determining the validity of all entries, including whether a proposed entrant meets the eligibility criteria set forth in this Notice of Race and (2) determining the appropriate handicap ratings to be used for each entrant.

**RULES:** This race shall be governed by the “*rules*” as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

**ELIGIBILITY:** This regatta is open to any boat that has a valid 2010 PHRF Southern California Rating Certificate issued before July 17, 2010.

Expected divisions for PHRF, Sportboats and Cruisers:

Cruiser Division, Any boat that has raced in two or more spinnaker races in regular PHRF will be expected to race in “Racing Class”. Entry into Cruising class will be at the discretion of the organizing authority, PHRF of SO CAL.

The So Cal PHRF Marine Industry Racer (MIR) rule will apply to all classes. However, individuals who meet the definition of a MIR under the So Cal PHRF Class Rules will not be allowed to steer/drive a Cruising class boat.

This will be a So Cal PHRF Category 4 race. On boats without lifelines, all crew will be required to wear a Coast Guard approved PFD (Type 4 or better when inflated) while racing except for brief moments while changing clothing.

**ENTRIES:** A person who is an owner or charterer of a boat may enter that boat by delivering a completed entry form and entry fee to PHRF of Southern California, P. O. Box 14356, Long Beach, CA 90803. The entry must include a signed copy of their 2010 PHRF So Cal rating certificate. The deadline for entries is 1700 hrs on July 30, 2010. Entries received after July 30<sup>th</sup> must pay a late fee of \$20.

**ENTRY FEES:** The entry fee for this regatta is based on a boat’s hull length as follows:

Less than 30’ = \$45    30’ & up = \$55                      CHF boats (all sizes) = \$25

**RATINGS:** Area B Buoy rating will be used on Saturday. Area B Random Leg ratings will be used on Sunday. Cruiser division will use Area B Random Leg Ratings without any Cruiser Handicap Adjustments.

**DIVISIONS/CLASSES:** There will be three classes sailing in this regatta. The Buoy & Sport Boat classes are scheduled to sail three (3) buoy races on windward/leeward courses on Saturday. Sunday will be one (1) Random Leg course. The Cruiser Division will sail one (1) “random leg” course on Sunday Only.

**NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:** Notices to competitors will be posted by 0900 on race day on the bulletin board on the right hallway inside the main entrance of the DRYC clubhouse (Notice Board). In addition, Notices will be posted on the DRYC website ([www.dryc.org](http://www.dryc.org)), which may not be possible for notices made on race day.

**VENUE:** The racing area will be on Santa Monica Bay.

**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing instructions will be available online on the DRYC website and at the DRYC front desk at least two days prior to the race.

**CLASSES:** PHRF Class splits will be determined based upon the number of entries received by 1700 on Friday, the day before the race. That information plus the Order of Starts will be posted no later than 0900 on the morning of the race.

**SCORING:** This regatta will be scored as provided in Appendix A of the RRS using the Low Point System except that all races will count (i.e. there will be no throw-out). One race must be completed to constitute a regatta. Saturday’s buoy and Sunday’s random leg scores will count for the series scores. Scoring for Sunday’s race 1.5 to the overall series score.

**TROPHIES:** Trophies will be awarded to the top finishers in each class based on class size. In addition the name of the winning boat and skipper in each class will go on the perpetual trophy for that class. The Perpetual trophies will be awarded at the Annual PHRF of Southern California member’s meeting in November.

**YACHT CLUB TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY:** Yacht clubs may enter a 3 boat team to compete for the Team Championship Trophy. A separate notice form is being mailed to each SCYA yacht club.

**HOSPITALITY:** Join us for a no-host bar and BBQ at our pool side patio following the race on Saturday: Dinner \$10.00 or \$5.00, Beer \$2:00; Wine \$3:00; Sodas and Bottled Water, Free. Sunday: After racing snacks and a no host bar. A Free continental breakfast will be served on Saturday and Sunday.

**RADIO COMMUNICATIONS:** The race committee may use marine vhf radios to advise racers of pertinent information on the water (e.g. OCS).

**BOAT STORAGE/LAUNCHING:** 2500 lb hoists will be available; at DRYC. Public ramp launching is also available. In-the-water boat storage will be available on a first come first served basis. To make arrangements please contact the DRYC office, 310-823-4664
